

The UKCA (UK Conformity Assessed) marking is a new UK product marking that is to be used for goods being placed on the market in Great Britain (England, Wales and Scotland). It covers most goods which previously required the CE marking.

The UKCA marking was due to come into effect on 1st January 2021. However, to allow businesses time to adjust to the new requirements, the UK Government recently announced an extension to the transition period.

This extension of 12 months from the previous deadline of 1st January 2022 has been introduced to give businesses more time to prepare for the new legislative environment in the UK following its departure from the European Union.

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In doing this the UK Government is also recognising that the COVID-19 pandemic has placed other considerable pressures on businesses during this time of transition.

From 1st January 2023 PPE products being placed on the GB market will need to be UKCA marked.

UKCA will not be recognised in the EU market. Products that require CE marking will still need a CE marking to be sold in the EU.

All products offered as part of our Exclusive Brand ranges will be dual marked to both regulations.

We are actively in the process in ensuring all our products are certified to both regulations and are working with a number of Notified and Approved Bodies to achieve this.

Over the coming months you will start to see the UKCA symbol displayed on our products.
